Yet another privacy concern for Google Chrome users! Previously, we talked about [Google's auto-login mechanism](#) which is hijacking our local Google Chrome data. Now, another Chrome 69 setting has come to light which is risking our freedom to remove data.

Spotted by [Jan !\[\]\(17413706fd4997a1a4bdf85c6864eee1_img.jpg\) Wildeboer](#), now Chrome won't remove cookies

and other site data of its own services in the "[Clearing browsing data](#)" prompt. In other words, data saved by Google services like Gmail, Google homepage, YouTube won't get affected in the process of clearing browsing data from Google Chrome.
